One keyboard. Two chairs. The comic carries the theory.

Most AI courses talk *at* a child while a parent hopes for the best in the next room. This camp is built for the two of you at one screen — because the judgement it teaches (**what to ask, what to trust, what to let an AI act on**) is a family skill, and it sticks when you build it together.



Session 1 opens with Misha's ninety-second comic: she asks for **"FOOD!"** ... gets buried alive ... then asks precisely. That's the whole theory of prompting — landed with a laugh before a single explanation.



A story, then a session

Misha, Buzzy and Mithu open each idea in comic form — so the theory arrives as a story, and the prose never has to lecture.



A bonding moment, every session

Each session has a designed two-player interaction — taking turns at the keyboard, judging each other's asks, playing against Claude together. It's the point, not a garnish.



A Parent Corner, every session

Five minutes written for the grown-up in adult terms — what this idea means for homework, trust, and screen-time conversations at your house.



Prompt cards, ready to use

Every session ships with copy-ready prompt cards — never more than ten, and every session is designed to fit inside the **free plan's limits**, with a written fallback if you hit them mid-evening.



Family missions between sessions

Each session ends with a mission applied to your real life — your trip, your menu, your homework folder — so the skill gets used before the next sitting.

Session 14 assembles everything into one genuinely useful family bot. Session 15 opens the Memory Box project you started on day one and turns fourteen sessions of saves into a scrapbook the two of you made together.



Quietly serious underneath

By the end, your child can explain context windows, tokens, hallucination and system prompts — the same concepts our advanced students meet — learned through games and family jokes, not jargon.



And the judgement to go with it

When to restart a chat instead of repairing it. What to double-check before trusting. What an AI may read versus what it may *do*. The habits, not just the features.

👉 The honest bit first

Three of the fifteen sessions demonstrate features your Claude account may simply not show — saved skills (session 9), connectors (session 10) and a thinking control (session 13).

You should hear that from us before you pay, not discover it halfway through. Each of those sessions is written to run fully without the feature, in plain words, in the same evening — because what each one really teaches is a judgement call, and the judgement transfers either way.

- ✓ One evening per session, the two of you at one keyboard.
